As East Texas Regional Administrator, Janet Kasper collaborates with a variety of public and private stakeholders across the southeast region to ensure the continuum of survivor care established in the region is functioning with the guiding principles of trauma-responsive, victim-centered, collaborative and continuously improving. Additionally, Janet will expand the geographic boundaries of the regional model to include research-based prevention programs as well as long-term services to build resiliency in survivors of child sex trafficking. Prior to joining the Child Sex Trafficking Team, Janet served as the director of a drop-in center/resource center for runaway and homeless youth, the Social Services Director for the Salvation Army-Montgomery County, Texas, and a conservatorship worker for the Texas Department of Child and Family Services.
